CAMPGROUND FEES (Prices may be subject to change without notice)

\$36.00 a night plus tax for Regular Sites including 30/50 Amp. Water, Sewer, Cable TV, and complementary Wi-Fi.
\$41.00 a night plus tax for "Premium Sites" including 30/50 Amp. Water, Sewer, Cable TV, and complementary Wi-Fi.
\$45.00 a night plus tax for "Super Site" including 30/50 Amp. Water, Sewer, Cable TV, and complementary Wi-Fi.
7th night free after staying 6 consecutive nights.
\$2.00 per night for additional persons, age 18 & up.
\$5.00 dumping fee for all unregistered guests. (There is no charge with a proof of residency for Branson residents)
\$1.50 bag of ice.

DISCOUNT FEES

Rally Discount: \$28.00 a night plus tax for Rally's of 8 or more (*Wagon master receives free site with rallies occupying 11 or more sites*)

Winter Discount: \$24.50 a night plus tax for winter reservations (*December 20 thru February 28*). Full hook-ups included.

Monthly Discount: \$588.00 plus tax for 4 consecutive week's reservations (28 days). Monthly discount is not available for Premium or Super sites. Full hook-ups included.

Good Sam's Discount: 10% discount if a current Good Sam's camping card is provided at time of registration.

Veteran's Discount: We welcome our Veteran's with a 10% discount from Nov 1-15.

RESERVATION POLICY

- 1) Call, mail, or e-mail us with your name, address, telephone number, length of stay, size of RV, and additional vehicles, boats, etc.
- 2) A non-refundable \$10.00 registration fee (credit card only) is required when making a reservation.
- 3) Change in registration dates can result in loss of registration fee and loss of requested RV site.
- 4) A 2-day minimum stay is required when making a reservation.
- 5) Minimum 3-day stay is required for all holidays and weekends in October and November. No refunds for cancelled reservations during that time.
- 6) The campground manager will reserve a site compatible for the size of your RV. **Specific sites will not be guaranteed.** Sites will be held in the section requested based on availability.
- 7) Payment in full is expected for reservation at the time of check-in.

RULES & REGULATIONS

All RV's must register at office before occupying site. After the office is closed, a list of open RV sites is available in the Kiosk.

- A. **CHECK IN / OUT TIME is 11:00 AM.** You must notify the campground office by 11:00 AM if you wish to extend your stay additional days. You may keep the same site *only* if it is not reserved.
 - B. Each camper must have or purchase a sewer collar.
 - C. After hours site availability is posted in the campground office window.
 - D. REFUNDS available on request between 8:00 am-4:00 pm daily. To be eligible to receive a refund, a request must be made by 11:00 am on the day the camper is leaving. Refunds will not be given after a camper has left park. Refunds are not available during the winter self-registration period from December 20 to February 28, or for the 28 day long term rates.
 - E. Solicitation and/or PEDDLING is prohibited (Ordinance 26-62).
 - F. Propane deliveries are not available in the campground. Propane available at the marina.
 - G. Campground restrooms and showers are for campers only. Access code information is available at the office.
 - H. BBQ grills and elevated fire pits are allowed. Please, no ground fires. A community fire pit is located at the pavilion.
 - I. **Please observe SPEED Limit - 10 miles per hour.**
 - J. Sewer hook-ups and a dump station are available for your convenience. Draining of waste water or gray water on ground is a health hazard and is prohibited. Airtight sewer connection is required.
 - K. Parents are responsible for supervision of their children at all times.
 - L. QUIET hours will be observed between the hours of 10:00 PM and 6:00 AM
 - M. All outside decorative lighting (with the exception of door security light) must be turned off by 10:00 PM
 - N. PETS are always welcome, however, they must be on a leash no more than 8-ft long at all times. Please have an adult supervise for children when walking your dog. Pets cannot be left unattended or left tied up outside. There are designated "potty" areas and **owner must clean up pet waste.**
 - O. NO PARKING is allowed in unoccupied sites (site may be reserved). Cars and boats may be towed at owner's expense.
 - P. Preserve trees in the campground. No cutting or breaking branches. No clotheslines allowed in park.
 - Q. Campers are required to turn off their generators between the hours of 6:00 pm and 7:00 am
 - R. No unattended RVs for more than 24 hours will be allowed unless arrangements have been made with the campground manager
 - S. Any person under the age of 16 is not permitted to operate a moped or golf cart. Golf carts not allowed on city streets.
 - T. No more than one RV and one car are allowed per site. Exceptions are motorcycles with small trailers and small trailers (with management prior approval). For instruction on where to park extra vehicles or boats, please speak to the campground manager.
 - U. Do not leave boats unattended that are tied to a dock.
 - V. No tent camping allowed.
 - W. All RV guests are expected to behave in a responsible, courteous and safe manner. Unruly or destructive behavior is not permitted and may result in eviction of the park. No refunds will be given. In more severe cases, management reserves the right to refuse future reservations to the park.
- **Please park your RV as instructed by the campground manager. Do not block two spots.**
- **When pulling your RV into site, electric and sewer hook-up must always be on the driver's side.**
- **If you experience an electrical problem, please report it to the office immediately. If you elect not to report a problem and call a serviceman instead, the City of Branson will not be responsible for any charges.**
- **The City of Branson reserves the right to evict anyone violating and/or destroying property or creating a disturbance.**
